

PERSONAL GEAR LIST

Please remember this is not a set list, but more of a guide on what to bring.....Scouts are to pack their own bags so they know what is in them.....NOT mum or dad!!

- ☺ Scout uniform, scarf and coat hanger (to hang your scout uniform)
- ☺ waterproof jacket
- ☺ 2 - jumpers – Polar fleece or wool no cotton
- ☺ 2 - t shirts
- ☺ 2 - long sleeve tops ie. Skivvy/thermals
- ☺ 3 - track pants (4 if you are very grubby)
- ☺ 1 - jeans (to be worn with scout uniform)
- ☺ p.j's
- ☺ 6 – underwear and thermals/spencers are good
- ☺ 8 - socks (a couple of thick woolen ones)
- ☺ 3 pairs - shoes – one sturdy boots, (bring gum boots)
- ☺ beanie – warm (woolen/polar fleece)
- ☺ gloves – 2 pairs would be good
- ☺ scarf
- ☺ camp bed/foam mattress
- ☺ pillow
- ☺ warm sleeping bag (needs to be rated for winter weather)
- ☺ scout blanket
- ☺ torch (spare batteries) – head torches are really useful
- ☺ toiletries (soap, facewasher, shampoo/conditioner, hair brush, toothbrush,toothpaste) and towel
- ☺ garbage bag (for wet dirty clothes)
- ☺ Dilli bag (plate, bowl, fork, knife, spoon, cup/mug, tea towel)
- ☺ camp chair

All scouts are to arrive in full scout uniform.

Please remember we are camping in winter so pack warm (think layers!), BUT keep in mind we do have limited tent space to store bags etc
